Thank you for your interest in our Summer Camp. We are prepared to offer you a fun and educational equestrian experience in a beautiful environment. We know that you will fall in love with our wonderful horses as you develop your riding and horsemanship skills.

You will find our equestrian oasis nestled in the foothills of Azusa Canyon. Surrounded by the San Gabriel River on three sides you couldn't ask for a more picturesque setting to further your equestrian future.

Whether you are a first-time rider, intermediate or expert equestrian, our Summer Camp will help define, strengthen and polish your position.

We are looking forward to teaching you the art and skills of hunt seat equitation (English saddle). Feel confident that you are riding at one of the leading training facilities in the country. Many of the horses and riders we train are nationally recognized year after year. We'll do our best to match you up with just the right horse, one that matches your ability level and compliments your personality.

You will enjoy daily riding lessons with our friendly, experienced instructors and camp counselors on one of our lovely school horses. <u>PARENT(S) PLEASE NOTE</u>: Summer Camp tuition is not refundable. We need a completed Registration Form and <u>payment in full to reserve a</u> <u>place in our camp</u>. Price of camp is \$520.00. We accept Master Card and Visa. Or, take advantage of our 4% discount for cash or check and pay \$500. Please make checks out to Rainbow Canyon Ranch. Checks returned for any reason will result in bank charges and may be subject to loss of camp reservation. Space is limited; sessions are first come basis. We require a completed Release Form and copy of insurance card on all Campers. Form must be completed by a parent(s) or legal guardian in ink on single page (not double sided) and turned in to our office BY the first day of camp.

There is a weight limit of 140 pounds. Riding attire is required. Please see our complete Riding Attire handout for details. Camp is open to girls and boys ages 7 to 17. We will do our best to place your child in the session(s) you have selected. We reserve the right to cancel and or combine sessions based on enrollment. In the unlikely event that your session does not fill we will give you the option of selecting another session or applying tuition toward riding lessons.

Please be advised that all campers must be "signed in" and "signed out" daily at our office or in the presence of one of our staff or camp counselor by a parent/legal guardian or person authorized by parent or legal guardian as listed on registration form. Extended camp hours are available at an additional fee and must be organized in advance.

2019 Summer Camp Information RIDING ATTIRE

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Here is a list of our required riding attire for camp. Please note that this is attire is required for the safety and comfort of your child. The boots are designed to fit the stirrups safely and correctly. Riding breeches or tights help with traction and help to protect your child's legs from friction rubs (regular tights will not protect their legs) they also protect our saddles from unnecessary wear. An ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet is designed specifically for horseback riders- bike helmets are not. Please give us a call if you have any questions regarding riding attire.

<u>HELMET</u> All students are required to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet in black (you can purchase a colored cover for your helmet if you wish). We <u>strongly recommend</u> that you have your helmet fitted (by your actual head size) at the tack shop as opposed to purchasing a small, medium or large helmet. Be sure you try the helmet on with your hair pulled back and tucked up in the helmet; since this is the way you will wear it when you ride (please bring a rubber band to pull your hair back - scrunchie's are too big to be worn under the helmet).

<u>PANTS & BOOT</u>S Riding breeches and tall, black, leather field boots or breeches and leather half-chaps with paddock boots are suitable. Half chaps/paddock boots may be a better option to get a good fit. If you would prefer tall boots, please call us first for tips on the proper "fit".

Please note that tennis shoes, cowboy boots, construction type boots and rubber riding boots are NOT suitable for riding but are fine for other non-riding activities. Please send shorts/jeans for non-riding activities.

<u>SHIRTS</u> T-shirts, polo shirts, and oxfords are all acceptable. Students will tuck their shirts in to ride, so avoid over-sized shirts. Shirts must cover up your belly button. We also suggest you bring a lightweight jacket or sweatshirt, as well as insect repellent and sunscreen.

<u>GLOVES</u> Leather gloves are optional.

WEIGHT LIMIT Weight limit of 140 pounds.
