All are welcome to our riding program. Whether you are an advanced rider, intermediate or if you have never ridden a horse we are prepared to give you a great mental & physical workout as you learn how to ride hunt seat equitation (English saddle).

## **HOW IT WORKS**

The program includes one group lesson (minimum of 3 riders) per week for seven weeks. We will give you eight weeks to complete the course. In the advent of inclement weather the course will be extended so that you will have the opportunity to complete 7 lessons.

Your actual riding (in the saddle) time will be approximately forty five to sixty minutes with total time at the ranch  $1\frac{1}{2}$  to 2 hours not including travel time.

# RIDING ATTIRE required and purchased at your own expense

**HELMET** 

All students are required to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet in black. We strongly recommend have your helmet fitted (by actual head size) at the tack shop as opposed to purchasing a small, medium or large helmet. Be sure you try the helmet on with your hair pulled back and tucked up in the helmet; since this is the way you will wear it when you ride (bring a rubber band to pull your hair back - scrunchie's are too big to be worn under the helmet.

### PANTS & BOOTS

Riding breeches and tall, black, leather field boots or breeches and leather half-chaps with paddock boots are suitable (best option). There are many economically priced boots available to choose from. Tennis shoes, cowboy boots, construction type boots and rubber riding boots are NOT suitable.

### **SHIRTS**

T-shirts, polo shirts, and oxfords are all acceptable. Students will tuck their shirts in to ride, so avoid over-sized shirts. Shirts must cover up your belly button. We also suggest you bring a lightweight jacket or sweatshirt, as well as sunscreen.

GLOVES - Leather gloves are optional.

We are located in Azusa Canyon, approximately four (4.2ish) miles north of the <u>210 Freeway.</u> Exit on Azusa Avenue (Hwy 39) and turn north towards the mountains.

Approximately (2) miles up Azusa Avenue the name changes to San Gabriel Canyon Road/Hwy 39. Continue up the canyon for approximately 2.2 more miles (you will pass the Forestry information booth on the right side of the road and the gated neighborhood (with 2 bridges) on the left side of the road).

You will continue about ¾ of a mile past the gated neighborhood and be on the county bridge, our driveway is immediately to your right *after* crossing the bridge (you can see our front riding ring from the bridge) you will also see the large American flag on top of our sign (the sign also reads; LAW OFFICE).

Turn right down our driveway and left at the bottom for customer parking. The Ranch office is up a little ways from the parking area on the left (pass the Law Office). You can see horses across from the office.
