RIDING ATTIRE

HELMET

All students are required to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet in black (you can purchase a colored cover for your helmet if you wish). We strongly recommend have your helmet fitted (by your actual head size) at the tack shop as opposed to purchasing a small, medium or large helmet. Be sure you try the helmet on with your hair pulled back and tucked up in the helmet; since this is the way you will wear it when you ride (please bring a rubber band to pull your hair back - scrunchies are too big to be worn under the helmet).

PANTS & BOOTS

Riding breeches and tall, black, leather field boots or breeches and leather half-chaps with paddock boots are suitable and the most practical choice. There are many economically priced boots available to choose from. Tennis shoes, cowboy boots, construction type boots and rubber riding boots are NOT suitable for riding.

SHIRTS

T-shirts, polo shirts, and oxfords are all acceptable. Students will tuck their shirts in to ride so please avoid over-sized shirts. Shirts must cover up your belly button. We also suggest you bring a lightweight jacket or sweatshirt, as well as sunscreen and insect repellent (the river surrounds us on three sides). GLOVES Leather gloves are optional. WEIGHT LIMIT 140# Additional clothing for non-riding activities: jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, etc. NO sandals flip/flops or open shoes
